**Speaker:** Emily Wilbur, MS, University of Copenhagen

**Title:** Glacial Cycle Inception in Greenland

**Abstract:**

Greenland has not always been glaciated, and the ice sheet was likely at a minimum- if it existed at all- about one million years ago (Yau, et al, 2016). Some studies seem to show that the ice sheet has occupied its present location for at least the last 7 million years (Bierman et al., 2016), while others would indicate that the island of Greenland underwent periods of more extreme deglaciation, and was nearly ice-free as recently as 100,000 years ago (Schaefer et al., 2016). This research project hypothesizes that the present day Greenland ice sheet formed approximately one million years ago under minimal ice, or possibly ice-free conditions, following Schaefer et al. (2016). We conclude that there has likely been constant glaciation in Greenland for as long as there have been eastern mountains on the island, although the growth, stability, and geometry of the ice sheet are heavily dependent on poorly constrained parameters (e.g., precipitation).

## Photo Spotlight


